Rural crime is often linked to organised crime which targets and exploits rural communities. Crime types committed by organised crime include plant theft, livestock theft, burglaries, poaching and hare coursing.

Farm machinery, plant and vehicle theft including quad bikes, modern and vintage tractors, tools and equipment are all valuable to criminals and are often taken from insecure farm out buildings.

Livestock offences include the theft of livestock, worrying livestock and attacks on livestock

Fuel theft, heating oil, diesel and petrol are all crimes that have a cost to the local rural community.

Fly-tipping, household and commercial waste are other crimes that have a cost to our local rural communities.

Poaching, deer and fish poaching and also hare coursing have a dramatic effect on our environment.

What can be done?

Marking and tracking devices are the most effective security measures.

Keeping gates to the yards closed.

Install CCTV and alarms.

Alarms on buildings fuel tanks and also keep regular inventory on your fuel to identify missing fuel.
